Mary's Village, Phase I is complete. It offers four, single story residential buildings with classroom and meeting spaces. Residents are turning their lives around thanks to the programming and stability provided by the homes. Phase II will offer 16 rent subsidized housing units for program graduates. Phase II plans are drawn up and permits are being pulled. Phase III, still in planning, includes 17,000 square feet of medical, administrative and educational space. When completed, Mary's Village will be a residential complex that will provide on-site medical, behavioral health, training, and supportive services for residents.
